on Wednesday passed through our city,
coming from the direction of Brussels and going towards Germany, via Liege. "We admired the superb demeanor of the infantry and the good appearance of the convoy which followed. The foot-soldiers each wore a leather jerkin as a protection against the rain. There was particular interest in the Scotch kilts."

Namur at this period must have resembled our western towns before the pavement era. Under the heading "Namur's mud baths," the Province complains, "Our streets and even our sidewalks are covered with a thick paste of mud, in which the public founders lamentably. The city authorities are cleaning up as well as they can, but owing to the shortage of equipment, progress is slow. We make a pressing appeal to the public that each citizen should clean at least his own sidewalk, and if possible the roadway in front of his own dwelling."

A Lem Burger, a butcher whose shop is 4 Rue Gravier, advertises his meats: Balled beef sells at one to two francs a pound (20 to 40 cents); ribs, 40 cents; beefsteak, 75 cents; hash, 50 cents; mutton stew, sides, leg, shoulders, 75 cents. Namur people were also looking forward to some frozen mutton from Australia, promised in a few weeks, and to be sold at reduced rates.

"This impatience," says the hungry Province, "will be all the more welcome because the majority of our own meat has been sold by the big merchants and farmers to the German army."

A boxing match. Street boxing matches were a feature of Namur's celebration of peace. On Nov. 28, at about 5 o'clock in the afternoon a boxing bout took place on St. Nicholas street, between two soldiers "who had celebrated victory too well."

The loser remained for nearly a quarter of an hour in "The Land of Dreams." Namur was enjoying comic opera again. On Nov. 28, at 5.30 p. m., there was a representation of "The Dugouts of the Drum-Major." In the third act the Tarentella was danced by the ballet girls, and, in the fourth act, there was a "great military march," depicting the entry of the Allies into Trieste. One hundred and fifty people took part in the performance.

The really big event, looming in the future, was the promised visit of the king and queen of the Belgians. By that time, surely, the mud would be cleaned off!
