Notes and Suggestions of Practical Utility ON THE FARM, FIELD, GARDEN AND DAIRY.

Many soils need lime. High small and work up. Grow your own fence posts.

Arrange to grow later crops in your garden when the earlier ones are removed. If you mix and feed grain, it is quite as well to grow oats and peas separately.

Don't spread over a hundred-acre farm manure and labour that ought to be put on ten acres. Grass grows higher around a stone or anything that acts as a mulch and causes ventilation.
