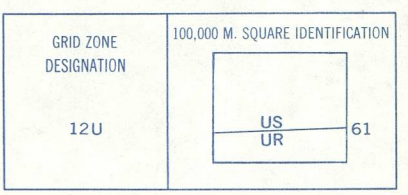

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING ARE REFERENCE TO A SAMPLE ONLY
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	5/975
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	98
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	4/984

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975984
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 62 miles)
