The county of Essex has for some years past set an example to other counties in the way of scientific agricultural experiments and its technical committee has carried out six years' experiments dealing with pasture land and the hay crop. 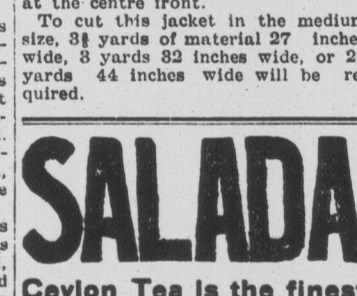
