

ELECTED M. P.'S.

Result of the Polling in Great Britain and Ireland,

Showing the Party Gains and the Majorities Obtained by the Successful Candidates,

Together With the Relative Increase or Loss in Most Constituencies, as Compared With the Figures of the General Election of 1892.

Following is a list of the returns of the elections in England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales, with the majorities in most cases, also the respective gain or loss as compared with the election of 1892. All government supporters are marked "U." (unionists) and the opposition with the letter "L" (liberal). The Irish members are divided into "P's" (Parliamentaries) and "A's" (anti-parliamentaries). "L" where used denotes that the member elect represents the labor party. Each seat captured by the unionists is marked with an "x" and each liberal gain of a seat is indicated by the letter "L."
