INSURANCE RATES TO ADVANCE IN MONTREAL

Underwriters Notify City Government That There Must be Better Fire Protection in Business Districts

Will be the Only Ones

Includes.

LONDON, Jan. 9.—It will be remembered that in the new scheme of training inaugurated by Lord Shelbourne, in addition to the annual manoeuvres, the Channel, Atlantic and Mediterranean fleets, with their attendant cruisers were to take part in fleet exercises of a confidential character at least once and possibly twice a year.

These exercises, like the grand manoeuvres of last year, will take place off the coasts of Spain and Portugal, the ships assembling at Lagos for the purpose.

IN DISTRESS DISTRESS

MONTREAL, Jan. 9.—The Canadian Fire Underwriters' Association has written to the mayor and aldermen of Montreal, drawing attention to the need for an investigation and remedy, of the existing state of affairs in the matter of fire protection.

The association does not make any suggestions, but intimates that the persistence of heavy losses caused by fire spreading beyond the building of origin must inevitably lead to the adoption of prohibitive rates for insurance in the dangerous parts of the city. The letter states that the companies "in any case will be constrained to reduce the amount of insurance which they are now carrying in the business section."
