Market immediately, and paying a fine not exceeding forty shillings.

In addition to the Thirtieth Article of the said REGULATIONS, it is strictly forbidden to suspend any flag or sign, whatever, projecting in any square, street or lane, under the penalty of five pounds for each contravention.

In amendment to that Article of the said Recviations fixing the fees of the Clerk of the Markets, the sellers of fruit, vegetables and pastry, shall pay in future to the Clerk of the Markets only three pence per each day, which three pence shall belong to the Clerk of the Markets.
