Was chief ed. of the *Courier*, (St. John), and since 1863 has been ed. and prop. of the *Daily Morning News*, same city. Has held various offices in the Grand Lodge of A.F.&A.M. of N.B., and was elected Deputy Grand Master, 1872. Apptd. mem. of Ex. Council, N.B., 20 Feb., 1873. Was an unsuccessful candidate for present seat, 1867. First returned at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Princes St., St. John.*
