issued by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, be declared to be no longer under the management and control of the said Commissioners, and upon, from and after a day to be named in such Proclamation, such Road or Bridge shall cease to be under the management and control of the said Commissioners, and no Tolls shall thereafter be levied thereon under the authority of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign and intituled, " An Act to make better pro-" vision with regard to the Tolls to be levied on the Pub- 10 " lic Provincial Works and for other purposes relative to "the said Works," but such Road or Bridge shall be under the control of the Municipal authorities of the locality and of the Road officers thereof, in like manner with other public Roads and Bridges therein, and shall be main-11 tained and kept in repair under the same provisions of law, which are hereby declared to extend and shall apply to such Road or Bridge.
