- 17. When The Speaker is putting a Question, no Member shall walk out of, or across House. The House, or make any noise or disturbance; and when a Member is speaking, no Member shall interrupt him, except to Order, nor pass between him and the Chair; and no Member may pass between the Chair and the Table; nor between the Chair and the Mace, when the Mace has been taken off the Table by the Sergeant.
- 18. Every Member is bound to attend the Attend service of The House, unless leave of absence ance of has been given him by The House.

## IV.—BUSINESS OF THE HOUSE.

## Routine Business.

The Order of Business for the consideration of The House, day by day, after the above Daily Routine, shall be as follows:—
