This is done during a period of revisionadding, deleting and correcting of names on the preliminary list. The revising period for this election occurs on nine days in urban areas, January 25 to February 4, with the exception of Sundays. Hours of revision will be from 10 to 11 a.m.-or longer if necessary-and from 7 to 10 p.m. Revision in rural areas will be done from January 14 to January 30.

To be eligible to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or over by election day, must be a Canadian citizen and reside in Canada.
