Prince" upon a map or plan of survey of the last mentioned Township signed at Ottawa on the 15th day of February, A.D. 1901, by Edouard Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and of record in the Department of the Interior, saving and excepting thereout all that portion of the South East quarter of Section One of the last mentioned Township, which lies to the West of the Eastern limit of the surveyed road dividing St. Peter's In d ian Reserve from the said South East quarter of Section One, as shown upon a plan of the said quarter-Section, approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the 30th day of January, A.D. 1917, by Edouard Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and of record in the Department of the Interior;
