Ladies of the Aldermen also have these Cards. Their seats are on the North side of the Daïs.

YELLOW-RED CORNER. (PRESS.)

Admitting to seats on the South side of Guildhall behind those allocated to Members of the Court of Common Council.

The Aldermen, on arriving, will proceed to their seats on the Daïs.

The Presentation will be made at the Court of Common Council.

Ladies with tickets for the Small Balcony on the North side of Guildhall will be conducted to their seats by Members of the City Lands Committee.

The Lord Mayor and the Sheriffs will arrive at 12 o'clock, and will be met at the Guildhall Porch by the City Lands Committee, who will conduct them to the Daïs in the Guildhall.
