In violence to the evidence - to their own honest conclusions - to their own self-respect - to the undoubted "great necessity of a general reduction in freight rates on basic commodities as a whole" - a reduction which could not be made as the Committee as itself found unless the Crow's Nest agreement be suspended - the Liberal members swallowed themselves and adopted the agreement made with the grain growers. The right-about-face report was tabled in the House on
