As per instructions in your letter file 3-13 (T.3) dated August 26th. 1948, please find listed below a report re your comments on our Robinson Treaty Annuity Paylist for the year 1948.

Garden River Band:

No 138 - Albert was adopted in accordance with the Statutes Governing Adoption in the Province of Ontario.

No 361 - In the remarks column this man was reported as a Non Treaty Indian rather than Non Indian Status. This has been corrected on our copy of paylist.

Batchewana Band:

No 209 - The father of this illegitimate child was Andrew Corbier a treaty Indian of the Batchewana Band under treaty number 265. The father does not contribute to the support of the child who lives with his mother on the reserve.

No 239 - The \$ 4.00 in question was not collected at treaty time but will be collected in the near future.

The number on the previous paylist has been corrected to read 259 rather than 258.

Mississauga River Band:

No 123 - The wife of this man was of White Status before her marriage.
