- Have you made any effort to comply with it ?

No. sir.

- You are ordained ?
- My ordination comes from the Bible.

THE DEFENDING OFFICER DECLINES TO REMARKE THE ACCUSED.

- Are youmerried ?
- Have you any family ?
- One, sir.
- How old !
 - About two years, sir.
- How long have you been a member of Jehovah witness? The first time 1 heard of it I was about 15 years old. I was not very active in it at that time but my wife and all her family are Jehovah witnesses and since then I have done my duty going from door to door.
- How long was that ago ? About 4 years.
