**JANUARY.**—We give prominence to the words of the Governor-General relating to the benefits of immigration on the class of agriculturists. He says: "I have met no one who did not gladly acknowledge himself better off than on his first arrival, and among thousands of persons with whom I have been brought into contact, none seemed ever to regret that they had come here. Undoubtedly their hardships had been very great, the difficulties of climate and locality frequently discouraging; their personal privations most severe; but the language of all was identical, evincing without exception, pride in the past, content with the present, and hope in the future. Let a man be sober, healthy, and industrious, not afraid of hard work, and I can scarcely conceive how he should fail in his career."
