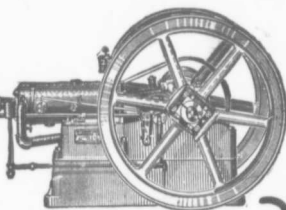


## How do you Grind or Cut Feed, Pump Water, Saw Wood, Separate Cream, Churn?
