A Bill in further Amendment of and Addition to an Act made in the 3d Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to enable the Inhabitants of the several Townships within this Province to maintain their Poor.*

A Bill for altering the Times of holding the Courts of Sessions and Inferior Courts of Common Pleas at *Liverpool* in the County of *Queen's County*.

A Bill to enable the several Counties within this Province to raise Money for Payment of their Representatives.

A Bill to continue an Act made in the 8th Year of his present Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act for granting to His Majesty an Excise on Wines sold within or brought into this Province.*

A Bill to continue an Act made in the 8th Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed.*

A Bill in Addition to an Act made in the 8th Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to amend, render more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Province, relating to the Duties of Impost on Beer, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors.*
