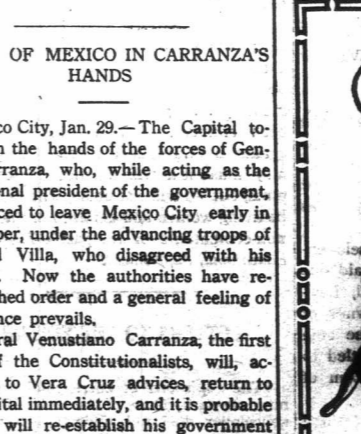

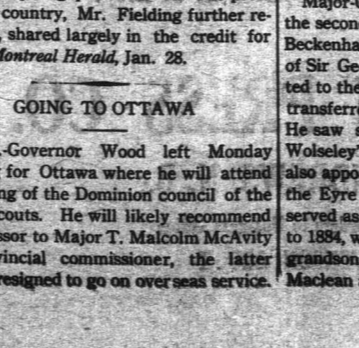

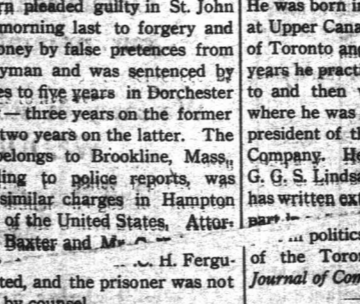

ON TRIAL FOR HIGH TREASON

Bloemfontein, South Africa, Jan. 29.—A preliminary hearing in the case of Barend Wessels, a member of the South African parliament, who was arrested early in December on a charge of treason, was held here Thursday. According to the evidence given by the advancing troops of General Villia, who disagreed with his policies. Now the authorities have re-established order and a general feeling of confidence prevails.

CHINESE CATHOLICS

The latest Catholic census for China shows a total Catholic population of 1,509,944. Last year this figure was stated as 1,451,288. The increase is, therefore, 58,656. In reality it is even more, because some of the Vicariates Apostolic there kept the figures of 1912 or even those of 1911 and 1910. The increase would be something like 32 per cent. The Chinese Catholics have 51 bishops, 1,422 European and 746 Chinese priests to minister to them. The catechumens are now registered in 13 missions. The total of the remaining Vicariates is 438,098.—New Freeman.

GIVEN FIVE YEARS IN PENITENTIARY

Irving Sierra pleaded guilty in St. John on Friday morning last to forgery and receiving stolen goods. He was sentenced by Judge Forbes to five years in Dorchester Penitentiary—three years on the former charge and two years on the latter. The defendant belongs to Brookline, Mass., and, according to police reports, was wanted on similar charges in Hampton and in parts of the United States. Attorney General Baxter and Mr. H. Ferguson, United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, and the prisoner was not represented by counsel.

A FAMILY OF SOLDIERS

Major-General H. J. Maclean, who died the second week in January at Argosur, Beckenham, aged 87, was the oldest son of Sir George Maclean, K.C.B. G. Maclean transferred to the 11th Regiment in 1845, he was transferred to the Rifle Brigade in 1853. He served in the Crimea and Lord Wolseley's Ashanti Expedition, and was also appointed Deputy Judge-Advocate in the Eyre trial in Jamaica in 1866. He served as D. Q. M. G. in Dublin from 1878 to 1884, when he retired. Two sons, three grandsons, and five nephews of General Maclean are now serving in the Army.
