## Editor and Publisher MUST PAY MORE FOR SEMI-WEEKLY NEWSPAPER

For some time the agitation for the increase of the weekly newspaper subscription rate has been going on with the result that many have adopted a price of \$1.50 per year, others have gone out of business and yet more have tried to hold on to the original rate of one dollar a year hoping that the limit of war prices had been passed.

The cost of living is still mounting higher and the cost of manufacturing the weekly newspaper is still increasing.

Can our readers think of any other commodity purchased in this Valley except newspapers which has remained unchanged

which has remained unchanged and unchanging year after year. Why should the newspaper rate remain the same now as years ago when we could purchase coal at \$4.50 a ton, wood at \$1.50 to \$2.00 a cord, chickens for 25 to 35 cents, geese at 50 cents, eggs 10 cents a dozen, butter for 18 cents, cows for \$20 and horses for \$75, beef and pork at our half the present rate?

Publishers everywhere are being vexed by the present condition of war prices in everything used in the manufacture of a newpaper. Paper, ink, type and supplies, gasoline for running our machinery, have, all mounted skyward, and the doubled cost of production must be met in some way by an increase in the subscription rate. The only alternative is to fall into the hands of the Sheriff.
