ELEVEN TORN TO PIECES

Most Horrible of Accidents by Dynamite Explosion.

Not Enough Left of a Single Body to Make Identification Possible - Air Filled With Debris and Fragments of Human Bodies-Limbs of Men Found Hanging on Trees 100 Yards Distant-Accidents Elsewhere.

Lancaster, Pa., June 11.—Eleven men were blown to pieces and five others were seriously injured by the explo-sion of a dynamite plant near Pequa, along the Susquehaina River. The dead

Most Horrible of Accidents.

The accident was one of the most horrible in the history of Lancaster County. The victims were literally torn to pieces, not enough remaining of a single body to make identification pos-

The cause of the explosion is not known. The two unknown residents of York County who were killed had just started to drive from the place with a started to drive from the place with a load of dynamite. They had scarcely gained a distance of 50 feet when the plant blew up with a detonation was plainly heard 15 miles away. was plainly heard 15 miles away. A great cloud of smoke covered the site of the factory, and when it had cleared away there was not a vestige of the horse, wagon or men who had left the factory only a moment before.

The air was filled with debris, and fragments of human bodies and pieces of flesh and limbs were found hanging to the contract of the second s

to the trees nearly one hundred yards from the scene of the disaster. The remains of those who had been killed were gathered up and placed in soap boxes, identity being impossible. The injured, some of whom it is thought will die, were taken to their homes in

will die, were taken to their homes in the vicinity.

The dynamite plant was owned by G. R. McCabe & Co. of Pittsburg.




