Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of a samily, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manifoba, Saskaichewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Deminion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son daughter, brother or sister of intendin

Daties-Six months' residence upos and cultivation of the land in each o within nine miles of his bon mother, son, daughter, brother or sis-

In certain districts a bomesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarte

Duties-Must reside upon the home each of six years from date of home-tead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has his bomesteed right and cannot obtalt ed homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside eix months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
