Vancouver, Oct. 7.—At a mass meeting of the anti-Asiatic league tonight speeches were made by W. W. B. McInnes, G. H. Cowan, J. D. Taylor of New Westminster, Rev. Dr. Fraser, and other local speakers.

Mr. McInnes denounced the treaty with Japan, showing that Canada's export trade to that country had decreased since it had been in force, and he called on the Dominion government to have it abrogated.
