Resolved, that the Committee in Halifax to whom the management of the Athenacum has been intrusted, be authorised to apply the sum of £100 in such manner as they may deem advisable towards sustaining that paper, in lieu of the loan which, by previous resolutions of this Division, they were authorised to make to the publisher; and that the appropriation of this sum relieve this Grand Division from any further responsibility in this matter.
