SUET PUDDING .- Three cups of flour, one of raisins, stoned, one-half cup suct, chopped ane, one-half cup molasses, one-half cup of sugar, one-half cup of .nilk, two teaspoons cinnamon, one of cream of tartar, one-half teaspoon soda; boil one and a half hours.

Put the celery in a salad bowl, lay the chicken on that, then put over it the dressing. Lettuce cut small may be used in the place of celery, but the latter is much more delicious. ### THE ABBOTT AND HALLIDAY LIFE OF BEKCHER.
