leges, and a conference on the methods of carrying on the various phases of student Young Men's Christian Association work in college.

Five normal Bible classes will be held each day to prepare students to become leaders of similar classes among their fellow students during year. The leaders of these classes will be Mr. N. Wilbur Helm, of Princeton University, Dr. Elmore Harris, Mr. Thornton B. Penfield, of New York, Prof. Rollin H. Walker of Ohio University and Dr. Howard Agnew Johnston.

The afternoons of the Conference are devoted to athletics and recreation. Lakeside affords ample opportunity for boating, swimming and rambling among the rocks, while athletic grounds will be prepared for baseball and other athlectic sports.
