

PEACE BUILDING

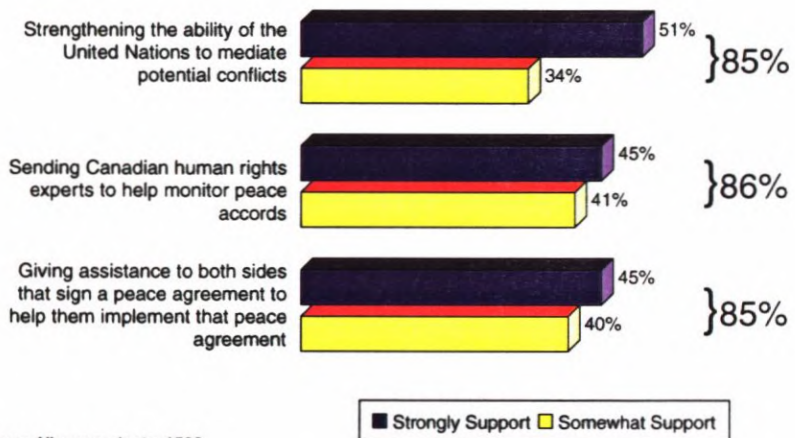
Respondents were asked whether or not they support Canada's participation in three types of peace building initiatives, as follows:

- Sending Canadian human rights experts to help monitor peace accords
- Strengthening the ability of the United Nations to mediate potential conflicts
- Giving assistance to both sides that sign a peace agreement to help them implement that peace agreement

All three received support from at least eighty-five percent (85%) of the population (total proportion of respondents who either strongly or somewhat support the type of assistance).

Support for Peace Building Initiatives

"Would you support Canada's participation in ...?"

"Strengthening the ability of the United Nations to mediate potential conflicts" received the greatest proportion of strong support (51%), while the other two types of assistance both received strong support from slightly fewer Canadians (45% each).
