The said Report was, on division, adopted.

The Honourable Senator Black, from the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce, to whom was referred the Bill (88), intituled: "An Act respecting Department of Transport Stores," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate with several amendments, which he was ready to submit whenever the Senate would be pleased to receive the same.

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk, as follows:—

Page 1, lines 18 to 23, inclusive. For clause 3 substitute the following:—

"3. The Department of Transport shall prepare an inventory as of the first day of April, 1937, of such of the stores mentioned in section two as are usable, and when such inventory is approved by the Comptroller of the Treasury the value of such stores as shown by such inventory may be credited in the Public Accounts of Canada to the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada and a corresponding asset account may be opened."

Page 2, line 5. For "utilized" substitute "used".

Page 2, line 29. Leave out the word "stocks".

The said amendments were concurred in, and—

With leave of the Senate,

The said Bill, as amended, was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill, as amended, shall pass.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill with several amendments, to which they desire their concurrence.

The Right Honourable Senator Graham, from the Standing Committee on Railways, Telegraphs and Harbours, to whom was referred the Bill (12), intituled: "An Act to provide for revision of the accounting set-up of the Canadian National Railway System," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate with several amendments, which he was ready to submit whenever the Senate would be pleased to receive the same.

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk, as follows:—

Page 1, line 23. After "advances," insert "and".

Page 5, lines 13 to 22, inclusive. For subclauses (2) to (5), inclusive substitute the following:—

"(2) Such by-laws shall provide for—

(a) the custody of the corporate seal of the trust;

(b) the execution of instruments by two or more trustees;

(c) meetings of the trustees, to be held at least once in every year, the giving of notices of meetings, the appointment of a presiding officer at each meeting and the number of trustees necessary to constitute a quorum at meetings."
