Mr. Smith: Mr. Speaker, I believe there is disposition on all sides of the House to an order which would permit us to adjourn for the supper break and deal with all matters at eight o'clock.

Mr. Kempling: Mr. Speaker, that is the result of the discussions which we have had. We will adjourn now, ring the bells at eight o'clock, and the question will be put then.

Mr. Deans: Mr. Speaker, I just want to make it clear that in my normal co-operative way, I intend to agree with that.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker): Then we will consider that the motion has been put in that fashion by the hon. parliamentary secretary. If there is unanimous consent, I will now leave the chair until eight o'clock. Is there unanimous consent?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker): Then at eight o'clock we will put all questions necessary.
