but if there is a proposal with respect to deferring the vote and the bells, the Chair would serve the House well by putting the question, dealing with the yeas and nays, and if at that point there was a motion to defer the vote until eight o'clock, perhaps it could be entertained. If that is an agreeable way to proceed, I will put the motion now.

Mr. Kaplan: Mr. Speaker, I was not party to consultations on this question, but I understand that it was agreed we would adjourn now, return at eight o'clock, and put the question at that time. If unanmimous consent could be sought, I believe Your Honour would find it forthcoming.

Mr. Smith: Mr. Speaker, I believe there is disposition on all sides of the House to an order which would permit us to adjourn for the supper break and deal with all matters at eight o'clock.

Mr. Kempling: Mr. Speaker, that is the result of the discussions which we have had. We will adjourn now, ring the bells at eight o'clock, and the question will be put then.

Mr. Deans: Mr. Speaker, I just want to make it clear that in my normal co-operative way, I intend to agree with that.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker): Then we will consider that the motion has been put in that fashion by the hon. parliamentary secretary. If there is unanimous consent, I will now leave the chair until eight o'clock. Is there unanimous consent?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Blaker): Then at eight o'clock we will put all questions necessary.
