In the British schools there are two certificates, one, the school certificate, and two, the higher certificate. The school certificate is of about the same standard asour junior matriculation. It will admit to British universities if the candidate has five credits. The higher certificate which is taken normally two years after the school certificate, is a very specialized examination, in which a candidate takes two major subjects and one minor subject. It is required for entrance to the honours courses in some British universities.
