

II. SUN. A Partial Eclipse, May 26th. This Eclipse is visible within the following limits: Eclipse begins long. 26° 57' W., lat. 25° 4' N., at 2h. 39m. A. M.; greatest aspect, long. 99° 46' W., lat. 62° 54' N., at 5h. 49m. A. M.; eclipse ends, long. 131° 13' E., lat. 52° 57' N., at 6h. 50m. A. M., mean time, St. John. Invisible in New Brunswick.
