That all fines that may be imposed under the provisions of this By-Law together with all sums that may be paid for subpenas, shall be paid to the Treasurer of the District and shall go into and form part of the general revenues thereof subject to the controll, direction and application of the District Council.

SECTION 5. That in all Cases, in which witnesses shall have duly appeared to give evidence before this Council, or before any Committee thereof either voluntarily or in obedience to a subpone duly issued and served, the Council or Committee (as the case may be) before whom they shall appear to give evidence, shall order and direct such witness or witnesses, to be paid for his, her or their loss of time and expenses, such sum or sums of money, as the Council or Committee, (as the case may be) shall deem just and equitable, which order the party or parties upon whom it shall be made, are hereby required and directed to obey.

BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the District of Johnstown, to regulate the appointment of Surveyors of Highways.

The Council of the District of Johnstown duly assembled in Council in the Town of Brockville on Saturday the twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, in virtue of an Act passed in the fourth and fifth years of the reign of Her Majesty Queen-Victoria, entitled "An Act to provide for the better internal government of that part of this Province which formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada by the establishment of Local or Municipal Authorities therein" do ordain and enact the following By-Law, and it is hereby enacted, That the persons hereinafter named, be appointed Surveyors of Highways, within the several and respective Townships of this District, having the same powers and authority, and subject to the same responsibilities, regulations and requirements, as the Surveyors of
