VI.

The Lieutenant-Governor of the Province, the Admiral Commanding on the Station, the General Commanding the Imperial Forces, the Mayor of the City of Halifax, the Minister of Marine and Fisheries, and the Flag-Officers and Secretary of all Royal, Recognized and Foreign Yacht Clubs, extending the same courtesy towards the Flag-Officers and Secretary of this Squadron, shall be, together with any gentlemen ballotted for (in accordance with Art. V.,) as such, Honorary Members of the Squadron and entitled to all privileges except voting at meetings or ballotting for members.

## VII.

Officers of H. M. Army and Navy and of all Royal, Recognized and Foreign Yacht Clubs, extending the same courtesy to members of this Squadron, shall be admitted on payment of the Annual Subscription, after having passed the ballot, and any such gentlemen owning yachts shall become entitled to vote on all questions when a vote by yachts, as hereinafter provided for, is called for.

## VIII.

There shall be Four Regular Meetings of the Squadron in each year, to be held as follows:—The first to be held on the third Thursday of January; the second on the third Thursday of April; the third on the third Thursday of July; and the fourth on the third Thursday of October.

## IX.

At meetings of the Squadron seven members shall constitute a quorum, and at Committee Meetings three members shall constitute a quorum.

## x.

Upon a proposal to alter the time allowance, rule of measurement, classification of yachts, or any other question exclusively affecting yachts, the vote shall be taken only by yachts, that is, the owner or owners shall be entitled to one vote for each yacht. Owners may vote by proxy, but such proxy must be in writing and shall be valid only for the
