AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE AUXILIARY BIBLE SOCIETY OF
NEW BRUNSWICK.

Section 1. Society incorporated.

Section 2. Power to hold real estate ; amount of.

Section 3. Bye-Laws ; by whom made.

Passed 6th April, 1882.

Whereas, There has been a Society in this Province in existence since the year 1819 known and distinguished as The Auxiliary Bible Society of New Brunswick, established for the purpose of co-operating with The British and Foreign Bible Society in promoting the distribution of the Holy Scriptures both at home and abroad ; and

Whereas, The operations of the said Society have been productive of much benefit ; and

Whereas, To further the object of it the members are desirous that the said Society shall be incorporated.

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly as follows :

1. That LeBaron Botsford, Thomas Wilder Daniel, William Elder, Joseph Prichard, James McMillan, Robert Cruikshank and Thomas Maclellan, and such other persons as are now or may hereafter become members of the said Society, their associate members or successors, shall be, and they are, hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of The Auxiliary Bible Society of New Brunswick, with the general powers and privileges incident to corporations by Act of Assembly in this Province or otherwise.

2. The said Society shall have power and authority to hold real and personal property for the purposes of this Act, and may sue and be sued in its corporate capacity in any court of law or equity or otherwise howsoever, provided that the real estate held by said Society shall not exceed in value the sum of five thousand dollars.

3. The said Corporation shall have power from time to time to make such bye-laws, not contrary to law, as may be necessary and advisable for its management.
