

REVOLVER.—Any, not exceeding $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches in length of barrel : minimum pull of trigger, 3 pounds. Revolvers must not be loaded until the competitor has taken his position at the firing point, and the chambers of the revolver must be empty before the competitor leaves again. A competitor must complete his score in seven minutes.
