### QUEEN'S NEPHEW ENGAGED TO WED DOROTHY HASTINGS

London, Dec. 20.—It is reliably reported that the wedding of Princess Mary, daughter of King George and Queen Mary, to Viscount Lascelles will take place in Westminster Abbey. The ceremony will probably be performed some time between Feb. 20 and April 1. It is announced that the Earl of Eltham, a nephew of Queen Mary, is betrothed to Dorothy Hastings, a niece of the Earl of Huntingdon.

The Earl of Eltham was born in October, 1895. He is the eldest son of the Marquis of Cambridge.

Moncton, Dec. 19.—Freeman K. Lutz, a well known resident of Moncton, died at the Moncton hospital to-day.

B. Hicks, a well known employee of C. N. R., died at his home in Moncton yesterday afternoon after a two weeks illness of heart trouble. Steves of Havelock, are sisters, and two brothers, Harry and George Hicks, live in the United States.

### COMMITTED SUICIDE.

\$50 Sufficient to Settle £78,000 Russian Debt.

New York, Dec. 20.—Brooding over the knowledge that he would soon be totally blind, Edward P. Kall, a patient at St. Luke's Hospital, 118th street and Amsterdam avenue, committed suicide by jumping from a third-floor window at 8 o'clock. He fell upon the stone paving of the hospital courtyard, and, according to the doctors, every bone in his body was broken. Kall, who was fifty-five years old, was a marine engineer. His home was at No. 66 Water street, St. John's, Nfld. Suffering from an affection which physicians later pronounced to be a progressive eye disease, he went to St. Luke's Hospital last October to get special treatment, in the hope that a cure might be effected. When the doctors at the hospital saw there was no likelihood of their being able to cure Kall, they told him about it and advised him to return to his home. Accordingly he was discharged from the hospital on Monday and was to have left for Newfoundland today. This morning Kall went to one of the bathrooms on the third floor and there, in sight of a number of the patients, threw himself out of a window. His relatives have been notified.

### STORK HELD TRAIN UP HALF AN HOUR

Fort William, Ont., Dec. 16.—When the fast Canadian Pacific train reached Russell, a few miles east of Chapeau, yesterday, the engineer observed a flag-waving figure on the track and pulled up his train. He found that there was no warning of a wreck, but an excited story from the section foreman at that place that the stork had alighted or was hovering over his little home, and he wanted to know if there was a doctor among the passengers.

When none was found a party of nurses, en route for Winnipeg, volunteered to officiate, and while they ministered to the mother held up an expensive unit of the great railway for half an hour.

### EASY REPAYMENT.

London, Nov. 28. — (By mail.) — A debtor who in 1914 borrowed £60,000 Russian rubles, then worth about £78,000, can now repay in full with £50,000. Judge Russell has decided in the Chancery division of the Royal Courts of Justice. However, a stay of execution was granted with a view to an appeal. The parties were the British Bank for Foreign Trade, which borrowed the £60,000 rubles from the Russian Commercial and Industrial Bank against securities which the borrower now sought to redeem. The lending bank, however, insisted on payment of £78,000 in sterling. The judge held that the loan was a ruble loan repayable in rubles, either Imperial Russian, or Russian or Soviet issues, whichever were available. Soviet rubles were quoted at about sixty for a penny at the time of the court's decision.

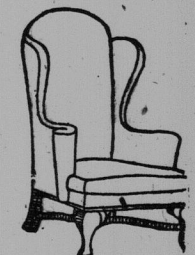

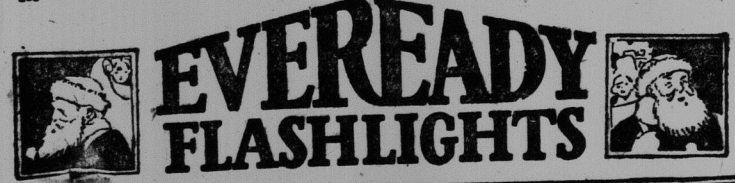
