The serious fire which menaced Upper Gagetown on Sunday and Sunday night was extinguished yesterday by copious rains, after all the available villagers had made a gallant fight and prevented it from burning buildings or valuable wood lands. The flames ran over a strip of land four miles in length and three miles wide, a total of twelve square miles, owned by the New Brunswick Companies, Limited, a corporation owned by British capitalists. When the fire was stopped it was within a short distance of Upper Gagetown. The total loss is not heavy.

New potatoes are now coming down in larger quantities and about 225 bushels arrived in the city yesterday from up the river, 100 bushels being brought by the Champlain, and 125 by the steamer Majestic. The potatoes sold at the wharf for 85 a bushel. Thirty crates of strawberries were brought down by the Champlain, and

thirty-five crates by the Majestic, the berries selling for twenty-five cents a box. The Champlain also had on board twenty-five bushels of beans and ten bushels of peas, they selling for 84 and 85 a bushel respectively. Six crates of blueberries brought by the Majestic sold for twenty-two cents a box.

wide, a total of twelve square miles, owned by the New Brunswick Companies, Limited, a corporation owned by British capitalists. When the fire was stopped it was within a short distance of Upper Gagetown. The total loss is not heavy.

New potatoes are now coming down in larger quantities and about 225 bushels arrived in the city yesterday from up the river, 100 bushels being brought by the Champlain, and 125 by the steamer Majestic. The potatoes sold at the wharf for 85 a bushel. Thirty crates of strawberries were brought down by the Champlain, and

thirty-five crates by the Majestic, the berries selling for twenty-five cents a box. The Champlain also had on board twenty-five bushels of beans and ten bushels of peas, they selling for 84 and 85 a bushel respectively. Six crates of blueberries brought by the Majestic sold for twenty-two cents a box.
