FORECASTS OF WORLD'S
COMING CEREAL CROPS

American Crop Greater But That
of India Smaller-Some Recent
Data From Official Sources

Several very important states have
communicated to the International
Institute of Agriculture forecasts of their
coming cereal crops. These data will be
found in the Bulletin of Agricultural and
Commercial Statistics of the Institute for
the month of May, just published. The
United States, taking as a basis the con-
dition of the winter wheat crop on May 1,
1919, as 100.5 per cent of the normal,
estimates this crop at 244,920,860 quin-
tals as compared with the final return
of 151,987,480 quintals in 1918 and 151,
000,619 quintals, the average yield of the
five years from 1913 to 1917, or 161.1 per
cent and 162.1 per cent of the two last
mentioned yields respectively.

The United States also, taking as a
basis the condition of the rye crop as
55.3 per cent of the normal on May 1,
1919, estimates this crop at 31,220,518
quintals as compared with 22,633,023 in
1918 and 12,700,754, the average from
1913 to 1917, or 138.9 per cent and 246.9
per cent of the two last mentioned yields

respectively. If the weather remains
as favorable as it was on May 1, until har-
vest time, a very large surplus in the
American yields may be expected, from
which the importing countries of Europe
may profit largely when, as may certain-
ly be expected shortly, the current of
international trade again becomes nor-
mal.

British India, on the other hand, will
realize a yield below those of 1918 and
of the average from 1913 to 1917. The
government of India estimates the 1919
wheat crop at 75,605,020 quintals as
compared with 103,342,140 in 1918, and
with an average of 95,884,353 quintals,
or 73.3 per cent and 78.9 per cent of the
two last mentioned yields respectively.

With respect to the extent of areas
sown in 1918-19, the countries furnishing
data since those published in April, are
Spain, Greece and Italy. The figures
communicated by these governments are
as follows:

Spain.....4,579,868
Wheat.....1,008,804
Rye.....2,315,142

Greece.....878,000
Wheat.....24,000
Rye.....121,000

Italy.....1,450,000
Wheat.....140,000
Rye.....120,000

Concerning crop conditions in the sev-
eral countries which have sent informa-
tion to the institute on this subject, a
summary may be made for May 1, 1919,
as follows: Very good in Ireland, aver-
age in Germany and Italy, poor in Al-
sace-Lorraine and in Luxembourg, un-
favorable in Greece.

The Bulletin also comprises informa-
tion as to fibre producing and oilseed
crops, as to vines and olive trees, as to

sericulture and sugar production. The
agricultural section terminates with the
most recent data as to the number of
live stock in Denmark, Italy and Sweden.
