

Screws, commonly called wood screws, two inches or over in length, 6 cents per lb.; one inch and less than two inches, 8 cents per lb.; less than one inch, 11 cts. per lb. (b). Other screws of iron, steel, brass or other metal, not otherwise provided for, 35 p.c. ad val.	
Hardware, viz.:—Builders, cabinet makers and carriage hardware and locks, 35 per cent. ad valorem.	
Muskets, rifles and other firearms, and surgical instruments, 20 per cent ad valorem.	
Iron or steel rivets, bolts with or without threads, or nuts or bolt blanks, less than three-eighths of an inch in diameter, 1½ cents per lb., and 30 per cent. ad valorem.	
Nails and spikes, wrought and pressed, galvanized or not, horse shoe nails, hob nails and wire nails, and all other wrought iron or steel nails, not elsewhere specified, and horse, mule or ox shoes, 1½ cts. per lb., but not less than 35 per cent ad valorem.	
Cut tacks, brads or sprigs not exceeding 16 ounces to the thousand, 2 cts per 1000. Exceeding 16 ounces to the thousand, 2 cts per lb.	
Wrought iron or steel nuts and washers, iron or steel rivets, bolts with or without threads or nuts and bolt blanks, and finished hinges, or hinge blanks, not elsewhere specified, one cent per lb. and 25 per cent ad valorem.	
Cut nails and spikes of iron or steel, one cent per lb.	
Iron or steel railway bars and rails for railways and tramways of any form, punched or not punched, not elsewhere specified, \$6 per ton.	
Manufactures, articles or wares not specially enumerated or provided for, composed wholly or in part of iron or steel, and whether partly or wholly manufactured, 30 per cent ad valorem.	
Carpenters', coopers', cabinet makers' and all other mechanics' tools, and saws of all kinds, thirty p. c. ad val	30 p. ct.
Files and rasps thirty-five p. c. ad valorem.	35 p. ct.
Knife blades or knife blanks, in the rough, unhandled, for use by electro-platers, ten per cent. ad valorem	10 p. ct.
Stereotypes and electrotypes of standard books, ten per cent. ad valorem	10 p. ct.
Stereotypes and electrotypes for commercial blanks and advertisements, twenty per cent. ad valorem	20 p. ct.
Stereotypes and electrotypes, and bases for same, made wholly or in part of type metal, not elsewhere specified, 5 cents per pound,	5 c. p. lb.
Tinware, stamped and japanned ware, and all manufactures of tin not elsewhere specified, twenty-five per cent ad valorem	25 p. ct.
Cans or packages made of tin or other material, containing fish of any kind admitted free of duty under any existing law or treaty, not exceeding one quart in contents, one cent and a half on each can or package; and when exceeding one quart an additional duty of one cent and a half for each additional quart or fractional part thereof.	1½ c. p. ct.
