The accused, No. K18092, Gunner James Malcolm MacDonald, No. 6 District Depot, C.A., a soldier of the Canadian Army, placed on Active Service, is charged with:-

SECTION 12(1)(A) WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE, DESERTING HIS
OF THE ARMY ACT MAJESTY'S SERVICE

in that he

at Halifax, Nova Scotia, at 2200 hours, on the eighteenth day of May 1941, did absent himself from No. 6 District Depot, and remained absent until apprehended at 1530 hours on the ninth day of July, 1941 by the Civil Power in Vancouver, British Columbia, dressed in civilian clothes; the total cost of his apprehension and return to his unit being \$115.55.
