Dr. Taylor committed a bill amending the law relating to assessment of rates

and taxes throughout the province, Mr. Turner in the chair.

After some discussion proposed was reported with leave to sit again.

Mr. Stevens introduced a bill amending and amending the act authorizing the Cotton Manufacturing Company to provide for a sinking fund for the redemption and payment of debentures.

Dr. Taylor committed a bill amending the construction of a private sewer by Samuel Hayward and others in Hampton, Mr. Harrison in the chair.

The bill was under consideration at 6 o'clock. After supper the bill was agreed to with amendments.

Mr. Ketchum committed a bill concerning a sale of real estate of the late Henry Appleby, Mr. Hibbard in the chair. Agreed to with slight amendments.

Mr. Bellamy introduced a bill amending the law authorizing the city of Fredericton to assess in aid of "Victoria Hospital," also a bill amending the law relating to the arrest, imprisonment and examination of debtors.

Hon. Mr. Pugsley presented a petition from the Yorksiders for a change in the mining laws of the province. On motion the petition was read by the speaker.

Mr. Jones committed a bill authorizing the commissioners of the almshouse and work houses in the parish of David's, Charlotte county, to sell and convey lands and premises, Mr. Stevens in the chair.

Agreed to with amendments. Mr. Stevens committed a bill to consolidate and amend the several acts incorporating or relating to the town of Moncton, Mr. Stockton in the chair.

Mr. Stevens explained the bill and said he thought that, although it was a lengthy act, it was one that was likely to be of great benefit to the town of Moncton to the city of Moncton.

The sixth section occupied considerably more of the time, the discussion being on a candidate for mayor as an alderman any other occupier or manager of "any hotel, saloon or premises where intoxicating liquors are sold or dealt out." Finally it was decided to let the section stand over for the present.

At 10:15 o'clock 11 sections had been passed and progress was reported with vigor.
