Azeff denounced to the police the ten persons who planned the attempt to murder General Trepoff. He himself organized the unsuccessful attempt to blow up M. Stolypin in 1906.

Azeff is also said to have helped the scheme by which the ship John Grafton was loaded with 17,000 rifies, thousands of revolvers, three machine guns and tons of explosives, which were to be landed in St. Petersburz for an armed rising. Gapon was in charge of the arms. The ship, it will be remembered, was wrecked in a storm. Gapon says "D. S.," saved himself by swimming ashore.
