I have the honor to state for your information, that I am informed by Mr Agent Martineau that some of the Half-Breeds, residing the Fairford Mission and who are allowed to take Treaty with the Fairford Band of Indians viz: William Anderson, Senior, Robert Sanderson, William Sabiston, Junior, Joseph Leclaire, and Bazil Letendre, representing widow Letendre, his mother's interests, are requesting the Government to grant them the Deed of the property already surveyed and allotted to them when the Fairford Reserve was surveyed.
