Obituaries

BROOKBANK Reg. No. 16648, ex-Cpl. Richard Gordon Brookland, 63, died on September 4, 1985, at Coquitlam, B.C. He was born on July 20, 1922, at Duncan, B.C., and served with the Canadian Army from September 6, 1939, to August 13, 1945, before joining the RCMP on August 15, 1950. For his service with the army he was awarded the Italy Star, the France-Germany Star, the Defence Medal, and Clasp and the War Medal 1939-45. His entire career with the RCMP was served in "E" Division. He served in the following detachments, Alberni, Kelowna, Vernon, Trail, Kamloops, Williams Lake, Burnaby Provost, Essondale, Port Coquitlam and New Westminster. On June 1, 1969, he was promoted to corporal. He retired from the Force on March 31, 1975.

BROOME Reg. No. 10924, ex-Sgt. Charles Roland Broome, 78, died on August 16, 1985, at Ongunquit, Maine. He was born on December 17, 1906, at Chester, England, and joined the RCMP on May 18, 1931. Following recruit training at Depot Division he was posted to Montreal, "C" Division, where he started out performing general detachment duties and accountancy work and later moved into civil security investigations. On August 30, 1937, he was awarded the Commissioner's Commendation and on December 21, 1937, he was presented a Commanding Officer's Commendation. On May 1, 1938, he was promoted to corporal and on December 1, 1938, to sergeant. He retired from the Force on May 17, 1942, in order to join the Royal Canadian Air Force.
