IV CONCLUSION: WHAT PRICE SECURITY?

We have in this brief outlined many of the injustices contained in the existing 'dangerous sexual offender' legislation and we have shown how Bill C-83 does little to change them.

Some of the injustices could doubtless be alleviated by amendments to the proposed legislation. The major injustices are:

- vague and imprecise wording
 - difficulty in determining dangerousness
- inadequate provisions for attempting to determine
 'dangerous (sexual) offender' status

 one offence is sufficient to lead to 'dangerous (sexual) offender' status
