Monday, 16th March, 1807.

THE House (according to order) was adjourned during pleasure and was put into a Committee of the whole House on the bill intituled, "An Act to regulate the Trial of Controverted Elections or Returns of Members to serve in the House of Assembly of Lower Canada.

After some time the House was resumed and the Hon. Mr. de Lanaudiere reported "That the Committee had made some Progress in the said bill and prayed leave to sit again on the ninth day of June next."

The House agreed with the Committee.

Ordered that four hundred copies of this bill be printed, in both languages, by the King's Printer, and be distributed by the Clerk of the Legislative Council to the Members of the Legislature, Justices of the Peace and Notaries in this Province.
