Second s. of the Rev. Henry Prior, late of Dallowgill, Yorkshire, Eng. B. there 21 May, 1853. Ed. at Leeds Grammar Sch. and afterwards at Wakefield in Mining Engineering. M. at Victoria, 30 Jan., 1878. Suzette, youngest dau. of the late John Work, Esq., of Hillside, Victoria. Is an iron and hardware merchant. Was Mining Engineer and Surveyor for the Vancouver Coal Mining and Land Co. from 1873 to 1878. Was Govt. Inspector of Mines for two years. Elected a life mem. of the North of Eng. Institute of Mining and Civil Engineers in 1875. Is Lieut.-Colonel in the B. C. Brigade-Garrison Artillery, V.M., and holds certificate of qualification from the Royal Sch. of Artillery. Apptd. an extra A.D.C. to Gov.-Gen. of Can. Jan. 1889. Commanded the Canadian Rifle Team at Bisley, Eng., July 1890. Sat in Leg. Assem. of B.C. from g.e. 6 July, 1886, until 23 Jan., 1888, when he resigned to become a candidate for present seat on its becoming vacant by the appt. of the sitting mem., Mr. Shakespeare to the Postmastership of Victoria. First returned to Parlt. 23 Jan., 1888, by acclamation and re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative. —*Victoria, B.C.*
