This is one area that causes a lot of controversy and concern. To start, a lot of people think that because you pay more you are getting better quality lenses. This, for the most part is just not so, as lenses that are universally known and accepted by contact lens fitters for their quality can often cost them less than lenses of a lesser quality or patient acceptability. In either case the cost to the fitter usually doesn't vary by more than \$5 to \$10 a lens.

This brings us to the confusing question of why the big variation

in prices charged. Numerous factors are involved and it will take some sorting out on your part.

When price comparing most people tend to look only at the inital cost and not the continuing cost. As all lenses eventually have to be replaced for a variety of reasons, lost, torn, protein buildup, fitting replaced for a variety of reasons, lost, torn, protein buildup, fitting and prescription changes this will, down the road add significantly to the overall cost. Ask what replacement lenses will cost, what appointments will cost, is there a refund policy if you can't wear them, do you get a warranty or insurance and after the first year what will the charges be. Last, ask what happens in a couple of years if the fitting or prescription changes and what it will cost for the new pair.

The continuing cost can turn out to be very expensive if a few pertinent questions are not asked. The more you pay does not necessarily mean the more you get with contact lenses.




